## What are flex dollars and Munch Money?

Both Flex Dollars and Munch Money work just like cash at all campus locations, helping to increase convenience and satisfaction. Flex Dollars are included with residential meal plans; however, they do not carry over between semesters. Munch Money serves as an optional add-on after Flex Dollars are used for residential students, while for commuter students, it can be a part of their meal plan and it rolls over between semesters. Commuters may add Munch Money to their account at any time.
